Meaning: Corroboration is the act of confirming or supporting a statement, theory, or alibi with additional evidence or information.

1. The lawyer sought corroboration of his client's alibi to strengthen their case.
2. The findings of the study provided strong corroboration for the existing theories on climate change.
3. Witnesses provided corroboration of the events that transpired on the night of the incident.
4. Corroboration from multiple sources can significantly enhance the credibility of a news report.
5. The detective was eager for corroboration of the suspect's whereabouts during the crime.
