Meaning: Corroborate: to confirm or give support to a statement, theory, or finding by providing additional evidence.

1. The witness provided additional evidence to corroborate the defendant's alibi.
2. Historical documents can often corroborate the claims made in personal letters.
3. Her testimony was crucial in corroborating the findings of the investigation.
4. Scientists look for multiple sources of data to corroborate their hypotheses.
5. The new data will help to corroborate or refute the existing theories about climate change.
