

CORVEE

Meaning: Corvee refers to a system of unpaid labor required by the state or community, often for public works or maintenance projects.

2. In many ancient societies, corvee labor was a form of unpaid work imposed on the population.
3. The farmers reluctantly participated in the corvee, knowing it was essential for the community's wellbeing.

5. Corvee systems were often seen as a way for rulers to mobilize labor for public projects without incurring financial costs.
