Meaning: Costean (verb): To excavate a trench or pit in order to explore and assess the geological or mineral potential of a site.

1. Costeaning is an essential technique for assessing the mineral potential of a site.
2. The geologist decided to costean the area to better understand the underground geology.
3. After costean excavation, they discovered the presence of rich gold deposits.
4. The costean method allowed them to expose deeper layers without extensive drilling.
5. In the field, the team used a costean to evaluate the extent of the mineralized zone.
