Meaning: COTISED (verb): to cover or adorn a surface with a layer of color or material, often enhancing its appearance.

1. The artist cotised the canvas with vibrant colors, bringing it to life.
2. After the storm, the ground was cotised with fallen leaves and scattered debris.
3. The chef expertly cotised the dish, adding a sprinkle of herbs for flavor.
