

COUNTERBORE

Meaning: A counterbore is a cylindrical recess cut into a material to allow the head of a screw or fastener to sit below the surface.

1. The technician used a counterbore to create a recessed hole for the screw head.
2. In woodworking, a counterbore is essential for ensuring that the fasteners sit flush with the surface.
