

COUNTERDRAW

Meaning: Counterdraw: to create a drawing that contrasts or enhances an existing sketch by adding new elements or altering its composition.

1. The artist decided to counterdraw the original sketch to create a more dynamic composition.
2. In her latest work, she chose to counterdraw the usual landscape by incorporating abstract elements.
3. To emphasize the theme of duality, the designer used a counterdraw technique in her illustrations.
4. During the critique, the instructor suggested that the student counterdraw the figures for better contrast.
5. By employing a counterdraw, the architect was able to highlight the flaws in the initial design.

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
