

COUNTERFLORY

Meaning: Counterflory refers to a design or arrangement, particularly in architecture or botany, where elements are positioned in a way that contrasts with or enhances the surrounding environment or structure.

1. The counterflory design of the building provided a striking contrast to the flat landscape surrounding it.
