

COUNTERIRRITANT

Meaning: A counterirritant is a substance applied to the skin to produce a mild irritation that helps relieve deeper pain or discomfort.

1. A counterirritant is often used in topical pain relief treatments to create a sensation that distracts from deeper discomfort.
2. Many athletes apply counterirritants before an event to prepare their muscles and alleviate soreness.
3. The herbal ointment contained a counterirritant that helped ease the inflammation in her joints.
4. Doctors may recommend counterirritants as a complementary therapy for chronic pain management.
5. The effectiveness of a counterirritant can vary greatly depending on the individual and the type of pain being treated.
