

COUNTERSEAL

Meaning: Counterseal: a protective seal applied to a package or container to prevent tampering and ensure the integrity of its contents.

1. The technician applied a counterseal to ensure the package remained tamper-proof during transit.
2. In the laboratory, the counterseal was crucial for maintaining the integrity of the samples.
3. After sealing the document, she placed a counterseal over it to reinforce its authenticity.
