Meaning: Counterwait: to delay or pause action until a specified event occurs or additional information is received.

1. The workers decided to counterwait the arrival of the shipment before starting the assembly line.
2. In the meeting, we agreed to counterwait the final decision until we had more data on the project.
3. To ensure all options were considered, he chose to counterwait the offer from the rival company.
4. Rather than rushing into a response, she preferred to counterwait and gather more information first.
5. The team decided to counterwait the results of the experiment before drawing any conclusions.
