

COWLSTAFF

Meaning: COWLSTAFF: A long pole used on a sailing ship to manage and secure the rigging and sails.

1. The cowlstaff is an essential tool for navigating the rigging on a tall ship.
2. During the storm, the crew used the cowlstaff to secure the sails against the fierce winds.
3. With a firm grip on the cowlstaff, the sailor climbed expertly up the mast.
