

CREPITUS

Meaning: Crepitus is a medical term referring to a crackling or popping sound or sensation experienced in joints or tissues, often associated with conditions such as arthritis or injury.

1. The doctor noted the presence of crepitus in the patient's knee during the examination.
2. After the fall, she experienced a popping sound in her ankle, indicative of crepitus.
3. The physical therapist explained that the crepitus felt in his shoulder could be a sign of joint degeneration.
