*Meaning: Cried: past tense of cry; to shed tears or make loud vocal sounds, often in response to strong emotions such as joy or fear.*

1. She cried tears of joy when she heard the good news.
2. The child cried out in fear as the thunder boomed overhead.
3. After the argument, he cried quietly in his room, feeling lost and alone.
4. During the emotional ceremony, several attendees cried openly, moved by the heartfelt speeches.
5. When she finally received the letter, she cried with relief and gratitude.
