

CROSS-EXAMINATION

Meaning: Cross-examination is the questioning of a witness by the opposing party in a legal proceeding to challenge the witness's testimony and credibility.

1. The lawyer's cross-examination exposed inconsistencies in the witness's testimony.
2. During the cross-examination, the defendant appeared increasingly nervous under scrutiny.
3. Effective cross-examination can significantly influence a jury's perception of the evidence presented.
4. The judge limited the scope of the cross-examination to avoid unnecessary delays in the trial.
