Meaning: Cross-purpose: a situation in which two or more parties have conflicting goals or intentions that hinder effective collaboration or communication.

1. Their conflicting goals led them to work at cross-purposes, wasting valuable time.
2. During the meeting, it became clear that their strategies were aligned at cross-purposes, creating confusion.
3. She often found herself talking at cross-purposes with her colleagues, making collaboration difficult.
4. The two teams were operating at cross-purposes, which hindered the project's overall progress.
5. Despite their shared vision, their different approaches caused them to act at cross-purposes.
