

CROSS-STAFF

Meaning: Cross-staff: a navigational instrument used to measure angles between the horizon and celestial bodies, consisting of a straight staff with a movable crosspiece.

1. The cross-staff was an essential tool for navigators in the Age of Exploration.
2. Using a cross-staff, the sailor measured the angle between the horizon and a celestial body.
3. In the workshop, he carefully crafted a new cross-staff to replace the broken one.
4. To ensure accuracy, the navigator adjusted the cross-staff based on the ship's current latitude.
5. As the sun set, the crew gathered to learn how to use the cross-staff for celestial navigation.
