

CULLS

Meaning: CULLS (verb): selectively removes or eliminates individuals from a group, often to improve health or maintain balance within a population.

1. The wildlife conservation team regularly culls the deer population to maintain ecological balance.
2. In an effort to improve the herd's health, the ranch owner culls the weakest animals each spring.
3. The city council culls stray cats to prevent overpopulation and reduce the risk of disease.
4. During the annual review, the board culls projects that do not align with the organization's strategic goals.
5. The tournament organizer culls entries that do not meet the required qualifications for participation.
