

CURTILAGE

Meaning: Curtilage is the area of land attached to a dwelling, typically including gardens and outbuildings, that is considered part of the property for legal purposes.

2. Legal disputes often arise over the boundaries of curtilage in property law.
3. A fence was erected to clearly define the curtilage surrounding the new home.
4. The curtilage included not only the backyard but also a small vegetable garden at the side.
