

CURVIROSTRAL

Meaning: Curvirostral refers to a beak or mouthpart that is curved and adapted for specialized feeding, particularly in extracting nectar from flowers.

1. The curvirostral shape of the bird's beak allows it to efficiently extract nectar from deep flowers.
2. Researchers noted that the curvirostral adaptation is common among several species of pollinating insects.
3. In the study of avian morphology, the term curvirostral is often used to describe the beaks of certain hummingbirds.
4. The curvirostral characteristics of the fossilized skull suggest a unique feeding strategy in prehistoric species.
5. Observing the curvirostral features of the new specimen, the paleontologist hypothesized about its ecological niche.
