

# CYME

*Meaning: Cyme: a type of flower cluster in which the main stem ends in a flower and subsequent flowers develop from lateral branches, allowing multiple blooms to grow from a single stem.*

1. The botanist explained how the cyme structure allows for the growth of multiple flowers from a single stem.
