

# DACAPO

*Meaning: Dacapo is a musical term instructing performers to return to the beginning of a piece.*

1. The conductor decided to start the symphony from the beginning, calling for a dacapo.
2. In music, a dacapo indicates that the performers should return to the original section of the piece.
3. The final performance concluded with a powerful dacapo, bringing the audience to their feet.
4. After the intermission, the orchestra played the piece again with a dramatic dacapo, enhancing the emotional impact.
5. Understanding the concept of dacapo can greatly improve a musician's interpretation of a score.
