Meaning: Daimio: A powerful feudal lord in Japan who governed large estates and held authority over samurai warriors and their subjects.

1. The daimio ruled over vast lands and commanded the loyalty of samurai warriors.
2. In feudal Japan, a daimio was often responsible for the welfare of their domain's subjects.
3. The daimio's extravagant lifestyle reflected their wealth and power during the Edo period.
