Meaning: DAMAGEABLE: capable of being harmed or impaired, especially under adverse conditions.

1. Certain materials are more damageable than others under extreme conditions.

3. Children's toys should be designed to withstand rough play, minimizing damageable parts.
4. When assessing the risk of a storm, it's important to identify which structures are damageable.
