Meaning: Damnatory: expressing strong disapproval or condemnation.

1. The judge's damnatory remarks left no doubt about his disapproval of the defendant's actions.
2. In her speech, she issued a damnatory critique of the government's handling of the crisis.
3. The article contained a damnatory assessment of the company's unethical practices.
4. Historians often grapple with damnatory accounts of historical figures who once held revered status.
5. His damnatory tone suggested that he believed there was no excuse for her behavior.
