Meaning: Damning refers to evidence or statements that strongly condemn or criticize someone or something, often revealing wrongdoing or fault.

1. The investigation produced damning evidence against the corrupt officials.
2. Her damning critique of the film left the director visibly shaken.
3. The report contained damning statistics that highlighted the severity of the issue.
4. Witnesses provided damning testimonies that implicated him in the crime.
5. The leaked emails were particularly damning, revealing a hidden agenda.
