Meaning: DASHED (verb): to run or move quickly, often in a sudden or hurried manner; also, to destroy or frustrate (hopes or expectations).

1. She dashed across the street to catch the bus before it left.
2. His hopes were dashed when he learned that the event had been canceled.
3. The athlete dashed to the finish line, securing first place in the race.
4. Feeling a surge of adrenaline, she dashed up the stairs to answer the phone.
5. The little boy dashed into the room, excited to share his news.
