Meaning: DBOUCH: (verb) to emerge or flow out, often used metaphorically to describe the transition of ideas or emotions into a more open or expressive state.

1. The artist decided to debouch the river's natural beauty through her paintings.
2. As the debate continued, he felt the discussion would soon debouch into a heated argument.
3. The narrow passage would eventually debouch into a vast open field.
4. During the hike, we discovered a trail that would debouch onto a stunning vista.
5. Their plans to debouch new ideas into the project were met with enthusiasm.
