

DECANT

Meaning: To decant means to pour a liquid from one container into another, typically to separate it from sediment or to aerate it.

1. It is important to decant the wine to allow it to breathe before serving.
2. After letting the stew simmer, she decided to decant it into a serving bowl for dinner.
3. He carefully began to decant the olive oil from the large container into a smaller bottle.
4. To enhance the flavor, the bartender suggested that I decant the whiskey before drinking.
5. The laboratory technician had to decant the liquid from the sediment in the flask.
