

DECANTATE

Meaning: Decantate: to pour off a liquid from a container, typically to separate it from sediment or to transfer it into another vessel.

1. The chemist decided to decantate the solution carefully to avoid disturbing the sediment at the bottom of the flask.
2. After allowing the wine to aerate, she chose to decantate it into a crystal carafe for serving.
3. To ensure clarity, the technician needed to decantate the mixture before conducting the final analysis.
4. He was instructed to decantate the liquid into a clean container while preventing any spillage.
