

DECISORY

Meaning: Decisory (adjective): having the power or quality to make a decision or determine the outcome of a situation.

1. The judge issued a decisory ruling that clarified the legal responsibilities of each party.
2. In negotiations, a decisory moment can change the entire course of the discussion.
3. Her decisory comments during the meeting helped the team reach a consensus quickly.
