

DECLASS

Meaning: To declass means to lower the status or reputation of someone or something, or to make information publicly accessible by removing its classified status.

1. The scandal was enough to declass the once-prominent politician, turning public opinion against him.
2. As they reviewed the documents, the committee decided to declass any information that was not sensitive.
3. The organization's goal was to declass technology that could benefit the wider community without restrictions.
4. In an effort to promote transparency, the government chose to declass certain historical records.
5. Activists demanded that the military declass the reports detailing the operations conducted overseas.
