

DECOLOR

Meaning: Decolor means to remove or reduce the color from something, resulting in a lighter or more subdued appearance.

1. The artist decided to decolor the canvas to give it a more subdued tone.
2. Chemicals can decolor fabrics, leading to unintended changes in their appearance.
3. In an effort to decolor the walls, she applied a special paint that lightened the original hue.
