

DECONSECRATE

Meaning: Deconsecrate: to remove the sacred status of a place or object, typically a religious building, rendering it no longer suitable for worship or religious ceremonies.

1. The church was deconsecrated after it fell into disrepair and was no longer used for services.
2. After years of serving as a sanctuary, the old temple was finally deconsecrated and repurposed as a community center.
3. To mark the end of an era, the bishop officiated a ceremony to deconsecrate the historic cathedral.
