

# DECRETORIAL

*Meaning: Decretorial refers to something that is authoritative or having the force of a decree, often relating to orders or measures that clarify or enforce legal obligations.*

1. The judge issued a decretorial order to clarify the legal obligations of the parties involved.
2. In her decree, the mayor emphasized the need for decretorial measures to address the housing crisis.
3. The council's decision was deemed decretorial, as it set a binding precedent for future cases.
4. He argued that the decretorial nature of the ruling would affect many citizens in the community.
5. Legal experts debated whether the new law had a decretorial effect or simply served as a guideline.
