

DECUBITUS

Meaning: Decubitus refers to a condition characterized by the development of ulcers or sores on the skin due to prolonged pressure or immobility.

1. The patient was at a high risk for decubitus ulcers due to prolonged immobility.
2. Healthcare providers implemented a strict repositioning schedule to prevent decubitus sores.
