

DEDUIT

Meaning: Dedit (verb): to subtract or take away an amount, typically in the context of financial calculations or adjustments.

1. The accountant will deduit the necessary taxes from your paycheck.
2. After reviewing the expenses, she decided to deduit the amount spent on office supplies from the budget.
3. To simplify the process, he asked his financial advisor to deduit all irrelevant charges.
4. The software automatically deduits any fees associated with the transaction before finalizing the amount.
5. In the final tally, they need to deduit the donations made to charity from their total income.
