1. The product was defeatured due to its poor sales performance last quarter.
2. After the update, several non-essential features were defeatured to streamline the user experience.
3. The team decided to defeature the outdated elements from the app to improve its overall functionality.
4. In an effort to simplify the interface, the designers defeatured certain graphics that were not user-friendly.
5. The game developers announced that several levels would be defeatured in the next version to focus on core gameplay.
