Meaning: Defection refers to the act of abandoning a person, group, or cause in favor of another, often involving a change of allegiance or loyalty.

1. The sudden defection of the key player left the team struggling to maintain its competitive edge.
2. Her defection from the political party surprised many, as she had long been considered a loyal supporter.
3. The spy's defection to the enemy camp revealed critical information about national security.
4. Defection can sometimes lead to a reassessment of one's beliefs and values.
5. The organization faced a crisis after the defection of several high-ranking members.
