

DEFENDEE

Meaning: Defendee: a person who is defended in a legal proceeding, particularly in a trial or lawsuit.

1. The lawyer prepared a strong defense for his client, the indemnitee, who was the main defendant in the case.
2. In criminal trials, the jury must carefully consider the evidence presented by both the prosecution and the defense for the defendee.
3. The defendee was visibly relieved when the judge dismissed the charges against him after the evidence was reviewed.
4. During the trial, the defendee maintained his innocence, insisting that he had been wrongly accused from the start.
5. The attorney's main responsibility is to advocate for the defendee's rights throughout the legal process.
