Meaning: Defeudalize: to eliminate feudal systems and structures, redistributing land and power from the aristocracy to the general population.

1. Efforts to defeudalize the economy aimed to redistribute land and power from the aristocracy to the common people.
2. The revolution sought to defeudalize society, breaking the bonds of serfdom that had long oppressed the peasantry.
3. By defederalizing the local governance structure, they hoped to defeudalize the political system and empower marginalized communities.
4. Historians debate the extent to which the reforms of the late 19th century succeeded in defeudalizing rural areas.
5. As cities modernized, many regions began to defeudalize, transitioning towards more egalitarian social structures.
