Meaning: Deflate: to release air or gas from something, causing it to lose volume or pressure, or to diminish in intensity or importance.

1. The sudden loss of air caused the balloon to deflate rapidly.

3. The team worked hard to deflate the tension in the room before the big presentation.
4. The mechanic had to deflate the tires to repair the damage properly.
