Meaning: Deflow: to disrupt or diminish the natural flow or clarity of something, such as information or water.

1. The sudden flood of information can deflow the clarity of communication.
2. Efforts to deflow the river for agricultural purposes have raised environmental concerns.
3. Her emotional response seemed to deflow the intended message of the conversation.
4. The artist aimed to deflow traditional techniques by incorporating modern elements into her work.
5. During the meeting, he sought to deflow the discussion to ensure everyone had a chance to contribute.
