Meaning: Defuse: to reduce the tension or danger in a situation, often by calming conflicts or disagreements.

1. The negotiator worked tirelessly to defuse the tense situation between the two rival groups.
2. To defuse the conflict, she suggested a compromise that both parties found acceptable.
3. The technician was called in to defuse the bomb before it could cause any harm.
4. He tried to defuse the argument by making a light-hearted joke.
5. In order to defuse her anger, he listened patiently and validated her feelings.
