

# DEGUM

*Meaning: Degum (verb): To remove a sticky or adhesive substance from a surface to achieve a smoother or cleaner finish.*

1. The artist used a degum technique to create a smoother texture on the canvas.
2. After the storm, the garage floor was covered in debris that needed to be degummed before repairs could begin.
3. To improve adhesion, the technician decided to degum the surface before applying the new layer of paint.
4. The old adhesive was difficult to remove, but a degum solution made the job much easier.
