Meaning: To deify means to elevate someone to the status of a god or to worship them as divine.

1. Many cultures have sought to deify their leaders, elevating them to a status akin to gods.
2. In ancient Rome, emperors were often deified after their deaths to legitimize their rule.
3. The author argued that society should not deify celebrities, as it sets unrealistic expectations for the average person.
4. Some religious traditions encourage followers to deify their prophets, attributing divine qualities to them.
5. In literature, characters are sometimes deified to explore themes of power and worship.

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
