

DELUSIONAL

Meaning: Delusional refers to having false beliefs or perceptions that are strongly held despite evidence to the contrary, often resulting from a mental disorder or extreme misinterpretation of reality.

1. His delusional beliefs about his own abilities often led to embarrassing failures.
2. After years of isolation, she became delusional, convinced that she was the queen of a distant land.
3. The therapist explained that his delusional thoughts were a symptom of his underlying mental health condition.
