Meaning: To demiss means to dismiss or remove someone from a position or employment.

1. The company decided to demiss several employees due to the budget cuts.
2. After a thorough investigation, the board voted to demiss the CEO for misconduct.
3. It is rare for a school to demiss a teacher mid-year without a valid reason.
4. The union protested against the decision to demiss workers without adequate compensation.
5. She felt it was unjust to demiss someone who had dedicated years to the organization.
