

DEMITONE

Meaning: Demitone: the smallest musical interval in Western music, equivalent to one half step or semitone between two notes.

1. The musician expertly transitioned from a major chord to its corresponding demitone.
2. In music theory, a demitone is the smallest interval between two notes in Western music.
