

DEMobilIZATION

Meaning: Demobilization is the process of discharging troops from military service and returning them to civilian life, often following a peace agreement.

1. The demobilization of the troops began after the peace treaty was signed.
2. Concerns about the economic impact of demobilization were raised during the discussions.
3. Efforts for the smooth demobilization of veterans included job training and counseling services.
4. The government announced a plan to facilitate the demobilization of military personnel returning home.
5. Demobilization can often lead to challenges in reintegrating former soldiers into civilian life.
